



## Stanley Dean Foshee

January 10, 1932 - January 21, 2018

An informal gathering of family and friends remembering Stanley Dean Foshee, 86, will be held on Tuesday, March 27, 2018, at 4:00 p.m. at Rose Hill Cemetery, where his cremated remains will be interred. Stan passed quietly on January 21, 2018 in Fayetteville, NC after a brief illness, surrounded by loved ones.

Born January 10, 1932, Stan was raised in the Tyler area enjoying hunting, fishing, and working on cars. Although he also lived in Arizona, Idaho, Maryland, and North Carolina, Stan was a proud Tyler-bred Texan through-and-through.

Stan also served in the U.S. Army from 1952 to 1954, at Fort Hood.
