A funeral Mass for Adele Bacile Johnson, 89, of Tyler will be held Friday, September 13, at 10 a.m. at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception with the Very Reverend Hank Lanik officiating. Burial will follow at Rose Hill Cemetery in Tyler under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Adele passed away on September 10, 2024, after a long and fulfilling life. She was born on January 22, 1935, in Tyler to the late Sheban Joseph and Milady Khoury Bacile.

She taught many family members and friends how to make grape leaves, tabouleh and kibbe.

Adele was an active member of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception her entire life. She loved her church and was faithful to its teachings. She also loved the Tyler community and volunteered serving those in need. She was a long time participant in Eucharistic Adoration at her church. She was a past member of The Cathedral Altar Society. She was also very active with the Boy Scouts and served as Committee Chair for Troup 333.

She started her career as an airline hostess for Trans-Tex Airlines. She worked for numerous doctors' offices and eventually started her own business offering medical claims filing services. She and John also worked together to build and sell many homes in Tyler.
