Mr. Caudle passed away Wednesday, November 28, 2018 in Tyler. He was born March 28, 1930 in Knox City, TX to Adrian Robert Caudle Sr. and Ruth Hanna (Simpson) Caudle.

He graduated from Tyler High School in 1948.

Bob joined the U.S. Navy in 1949 and served in the Korean Campaign aboard the USS Valley Forge and USS Essex from 1951-52. He was honorably discharged in 1953.

Bob continued his education at Tyler Junior College, East Texas State College and University of Texas at Tyler.

He worked in the oil and gas industry starting in 1955 and continued until retirement in 2011. He was involved in the organization of several partnerships and corporations throughout his professional career.

Bob served as Chairman, Treasurer, Elder and Deacon of Ross Avenue Christian Church, Ridgeview Christian Church, and University Christian Church all located in Tyler.

He was a member and former Chairman of the Board of the Lighthouse for the Blind, Tyler (DBA Horizon Industries), held most offices with the Tyler Lions Club and recently received the Honorary Lions Lifetime Membership Award. He was a past member of the Tyler Junior College Tennis Advisory Committee, and served 5 years on the Hollytree country Club Advisory Board. Bob was a proud Lifetime Member of the NRA.

Bob enjoyed tennis, traveling, photography, spending time with family and ranching.

Bob was preceded in death by his daughter, Lynn Louise Sharaa, of Tyler.

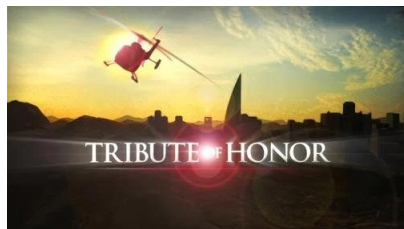
