Albert "Robby" Wynn, 82, passed away Thursday, June 21, 2018 in Tyler. He was born in San Marcos, TX to Guy and Oma Wynn. 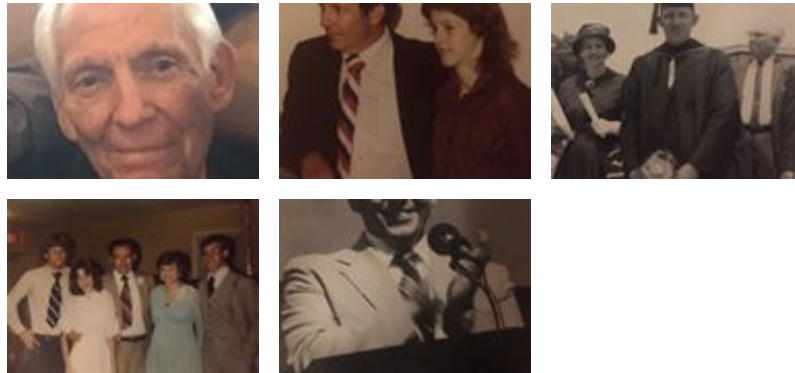
