Alfred H. "Freddy" Spurlock, 65, of Tyler, Texas, formally of McAlester, Oklahoma, died Saturday, March 7, 2009 in Tyler, Texas. Main, Eufaula, Oklahoma. Final resting place will be at the Greenwood Cemetery in Eufaula. He was born in McAlester on July 28, 1943. He was the son of Alfred H. Spurlock Sr. and Mary (O'Brien) Kirkpatrick. He attended St. John's Catholic School and graduated from McAlester High School in 1961. From 1966 to 1973, he worked in production at the US Naval Ammunition Plant in McAlester. In 1977, he received his certification from Okmulgee Technical School as a Heat and Air Technician. He married Ruth Pollard on November 5, 1974. In 1978, they moved to Tyler, Texas where he went to work for the General Electric Company which later became Trane Inc. as a lab tech. He retired from Trane with 30 years of service. He also owned and operated Spurlock's Refrigeration and Appliance Service from 1977 to 2003. He was a beloved husband, father, grandfather and brother.
