Services for Allen Wayne Clem, 75, of Whitehouse, Texas will be held on Monday, January 18, 2016 at 1:00 pm at Pollard United Methodist Church with Reverend Richard Luna officiating. Burial will follow at Whitehouse Cemetery in Whitehouse, Texas under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Mr. Clem passed away on January 15, 2016 in Tyler Texas. He was born on October 18, 1940, to the late Roy and Minnie Lee Clem. Never a dull moment with Wayne, he was charismatic, compassionate and a giver of his time, friendship and love. He and Becky traveled, seeing the country in their RV. Always the outdoorsman, you could find him working on a project, gardening, hunting, fishing or golfing. He was a volunteer with Hospice of East Texas, UMCOR, Methodist Missions, Texas Ramps Project, Pollard Theatre, and Methodist Youth Foundation.
