



## Amelia Louise-Kamel Procell

January 10, 1935 - February 11, 2014

A funeral mass for Amelia Louise Rose (Kamel) Procell, age 79, will be held Friday, February 14, 2014 at 11:00 AM at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception with Bishop Joseph Strickland officiating. Burial will follow the funeral at Rose Hill cemetery, under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Amelia went to the Lord on Tuesday, February 11, 2014. Amelia was born in Tyler on January 10th 1935 to the late Namie and Emily Kamel.

Amelia grew up in Tyler, and was a graduate of Tyler High and Tyler Junior College. She did several things during her life: managed Kamel's Variety Store for 10 years, and then worked at Tyler Bank and Trust until she started a family.
