Ann passed away Wednesday, February 4, 2015 in Tyler.

Ann was born February 11, 1932, in Palestine to Strode V. and Lola Wilkinson Davis. She graduated from Palestine High School and attended Texas Christian University and The University of Texas in Austin. While her husband Jim was in dental school, Ann took time off from her education and worked as a Claims Supervisor for Allstate Insurance and raised her family. Ann later went on to complete her education at Stephen F. Austin University in Nacogdoches where she earned her Bachelor of Arts and Master of Arts degrees. She was an art instructor at Tyler Junior College for eighteen years.

Ann was a member of the Smith County Dental Auxiliary and the Salvation Army Auxiliary. She was a member of Marvin United Methodist since 1962 where she and her husband Jim attended the Pairs and Parents Sunday

School class. She was active with the Missions Team of Marvin United Methodist Church, attending several mission trips, and was also active with the Wonderful Wednesday program of St. Paul Children's Foundation. Ann enjoyed painting, sculpture, reading, travel, and especially mission projects and art projects. She loved spending time with family and said her fondest memories are the births of her two sons.
