Anna Loraine Henderson, 94, of Marshall passed away Monday, April 6th, 2015 in Tyler, Texas.

Anna was born on May 26, 1920 to Ruben and Grace Finch of Cambridge, Nebraska. Anna attended a private college in Crete, NE as well as Doane College and the University of Wyoming in Laramie, WY where she received a BA in Education.
