Services for Annelle Harris, 89, of Tyler are scheduled for Tuesday, September 20, 2011 at 2:00 PM at Stewart Family Funeral Home, with James Fife officiating. Mrs. Harris died Saturday at the Hospice Homeplace in Tyler. She was born September 11, 1922 to the late Jim and Mamie Glaspie in Troup. She graduated from Whitehouse schools and after graduation she married W.H. Theriot of Port Arthur. Mr. Theriot was killed in 1953 and she later married Claude Harris, who preceded her in death, along with a brother, Alton Glaspie. Annelle was a loyal member of Glenwood Church of Christ. She loved her church and her friends there dearly. Annelle and Claude began in the real estate business in Tyler in 1967 and later opened ERA Harris Realty and Land office. She was the first woman elected as the President of the Tyler Board of Realtors. She also served as the President of the Women's Council of Realtors and received the Realtor of the Year award in 1985 and the Glover Tunnell Award of Excellence in 2000. She sold her real estate company in 1997 and joined her son, David Theriot in his company. She is survived by her son, David Theriot and wife Pam of Tyler, daughter Claudette Brumley of Tyler, grandchildren, Kim McAuliffe and husband James of Houston, Debbie Hodde and husband Randy of Brenham, Amber Hill and husband Chris of the Woodlands, Adam Brumley and wife Jill of Tyler, Matt Theriot of Shreveport, Louisiana, Chelsey Miller and husband Keith of Tyler, Coleman Fitzgerald, Haley Fitzgerald, and Blake Burrell, all of Tyler, brother, J.B.
