



Arnold William "Bill" Zabriskie

Services for Arnold William "Bill" Zabriskie, 88, of Tyler, will be held on Sunday, February 7, 2016 at 3:00 PM at Stewart Family Funeral Home with Rev. Robert Carter officiating.

Mr. Zabriskie passed away Thursday, February 4, 2016 at his home in Tyler. He was born on April 11, 1927 in Raymond, Alberta, Canada to Arnold Hooper and Barbara Goodridge Zabriskie.

Bill served in the U. S. Army during World War II in Panama and during the Korean Conflict. After graduating from Brigham Young University with a degree in geology, Bill worked for oil and mining companies, namely Phillips Petroleum in Louisiana, Standard Oil of California, Union Pacific Railroad and Rocky Mountain Energy in Denver, Colorado. After retirement he moved to Tyler and joined Colonial Hills Baptist Church where he was a member of the Silvernotes Choir and taught Sunday school. He married Lurline Magouirk on August 9, 1953 in Bakersfield, California. Soon after, they moved to Seattle, Washington followed by Anchorage, Alaska. Returning to California, he started working for Union Pacific Railroad in the Natural Resources Division. He was later transferred to Denver, Colorado, working for Rocky Mountain Energy.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Zabriskie was preceded in death by sisters, Virginia Zabriskie Fielding and Joanne Zabriskie Carter and brother, Richard

Goodridge, all of Orem, Utah.

Bill is survived by his wife of 63 years, Lurline Zabriskie of Tyler; son, Mark Zabriskie and wife Dawn of San Diego, California; daughter, Karen Vaughan and her husband Daniel of Flint; grandchildren, Aaron, Andy, Lindy, Melissa, Rachel, Phillip, Caleb, Joseph and Rebecca and their spouses; twelve great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.
