Services for Arthur Louis Umberger, 88, of Tyler, will be held on Tuesday, February 8, 2011 at 1:30 PM at Stewart Family Funeral Home Chapel with Rev. Ray Alden and Rev. Randy Clay officiating. He was born August 30, 1922 in Hennessey, OK to George Washington and Hattie Gregory Umberger. Arthur joined the Air Force at age 18 serving during WWII where he flew 50 missions. He retired as a Major after serving 23 years. During his last five years in the Air Force, Arthur served in Panama and flew air to sea rescue missions. On July 9, 1984, he was ordained as a minister. Arthur enjoyed prison ministry and started the Lord's Refuge Church in Tyler, 27 years ago. Arthur was preceded in death by his parents and his sister.
