



## Barbara Ann Wright

December 9, 1930 - August 5, 2013

Memorial services for Barbara Ann Wright, 82, of Tyler, will be held on Thursday, August 8, 2013 at 11:00 AM at the First Presbyterian Church with Dr. Stuart Baskin officiating, under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.
