Barry, a public servant and loving family man, was born on December 13, 1952, and left this Earth to meet Jesus on Saturday, April 13, 2024, with his family by his side after a courageous six-year fight against Parkinson's and Lewy Body dementia.

Barry was born in Ft. Belvoir, Virginia and lived all over as a military child. He attended Tyler Junior College and then the police academy. He joined the Department of Public Safety starting in the driver's license office and retiring as a senior corporal with over 32 years of service. After retirement, he continued to serve as a Deputy Constable for three additional years.

Barry loved being outside tending to his flower beds and garden. When not outside, he could be found watching the birds from his chair with his dogs in his lap. He was known for his witty remarks and lively storytelling.

Barry is survived by his loving wife of 20 years Susanne, twin daughters Benita (Zach) Tomlinson and Bethany (Trae) Sutton, stepdaughter Lauren (Teddy) Milton, mother Terry Goines, three sisters, Misty (Lane) Sumner, Sandy (Pete) Warner and Terry Lynn (Waymon) Hubany, 7 grandchildren and

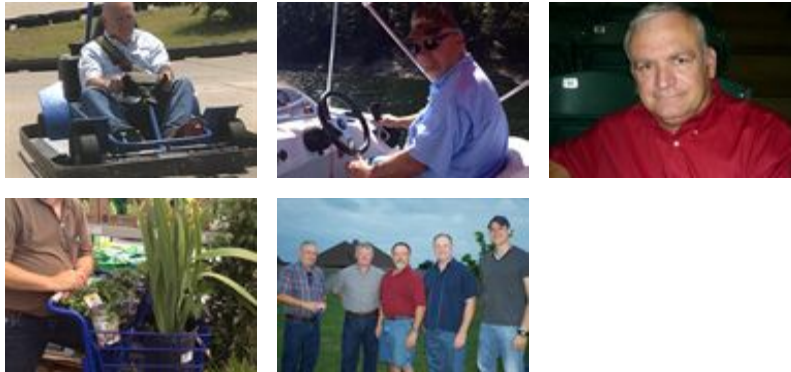
