Born in Tyler, Texas August 12, 1951 to Irene and W.B. Northcutt, Becky was raised outside Jacksonville, Texas. An only child, she was doted upon by her loving parents. She attended Jacksonville High School where she was a majorette in the school's band. After graduating in 1969, Becky continued that love for performing as a member of the world-famous Tyler Junior College Apache Belles.

Becky then pursued her teaching degree from East Texas State University in Commerce, Texas where she was both the lead majorette and a member of Gamma Phi Beta Sorority.
