BJ was witty and wise beyond his years. He touched many lives, changing those who knew him for the better. For BJ, the battle was won. Our worst day was his best as he is now in the presence of Jesus, his savior. While we cannot change some things in life, we can change how we live our lives. BJ's work is finished here, but ours is not - Make it count! From here until we reach the end of our days, we can LIVE LIKE BJ SPARKS.

BJ was preceded in death by his father, Benjamin D. Sparks; grandfather, Robert Edwards; uncle, Robert (Bobby) Edwards; his paternal grandmother and grandfather, Evelyn and Doyle Sparks.

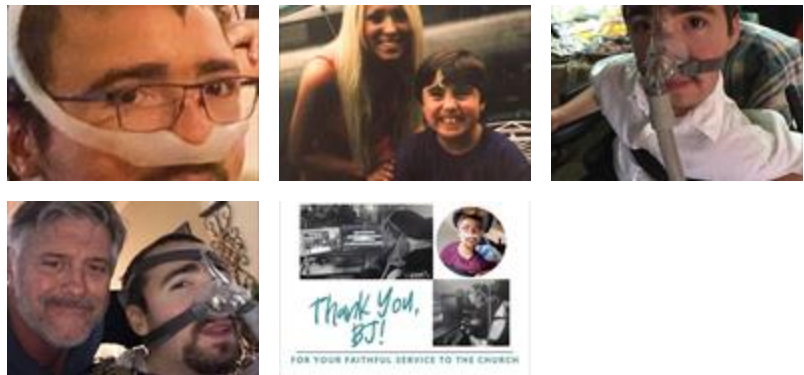

BJ was first and foremost a Christian. He made me a better Christian. Iron sharpens iron. He was not overly pious or stodgy in any way. There was a large age gap between us but that was the only gap between us. He could have been someone from my graduation class. He was witty and had razor sharp timing and could be dry or sarcastic at times as well. We would exchange insults on a daily basis and no one could make me laugh at myself like BJ. "You're dismissed." "I'm what?". "You're dismissed. You may go now." He never let me forget taking cupcakes from the dentist's office. He would give me brake pedal reminders when we would go out somewhere and we agreed that he could have three and no more and he would usually burn the first one before we got out of the driveway. Because of his condition, he needed to keep his room rather warm so of course I am terribly hot natured so that led to an almost daily exchange of myself walking into his room and immediately kicking over his small space here so it would turn off and BJ telling me, " get saved. " We talked about the Bible and we talked about Jesus and we talked about the horrible state of our country and we talked about our weaknesses. We walked around the block together and sometimes I would jog for a little ways and sometimes he would speed by me and then do a 180 and come zooming back by me grinning from ear to ear. We misbehaved at restaurants together and he made me laugh until I choked or cried many times.

BJ was never a bum and always wanted to do more and work more. We did doordash together and I could spend the next half hour talking about our exploits doing that. He reminded me frequently to be nice to others and to watch my words carefully.

I miss him terribly and I get choked several times a day but I have also laughed in the midst of my tears picturing him running all over the place in heaven with that irrepressible smile. We shared a song together, "Jesus Loves Me More Than You." ... You got there first BJ so I guess we know the truth now. ❤️🙌
