



## Betty S. Coburn

December 17, 1928 - January 31, 2019

Mrs. Coburn passed away Thursday, January 31, 2019 in Tyler. She was born December 17, 1928 in Seminole, Oklahoma to Fred Lyon and Lillie Clarine Narcomy Lyon.

Betty moved to East Texas when she was 3 years old. She graduated from Arp High School in 1946 and went on to attend the Federal Institute of Business, after which she worked for Dr. Monagan D.D.S. in Overton. She met and married Jean E. Sadler from New London in 1948 and their marriage lasted 53 years, until his death in 2001. They moved to Snyder in 1957 and transferred to Big Spring in 1972, where she worked for Big Spring ISD. There was one more transfer to Midland in 1979 and then, upon retiring in 1991, they moved back to Tyler where they belonged to Colonial Hills Baptist Church.

Betty was happiest when cooking and caring for her family and home.

Betty was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Jean Sadler and her second husband, John Coburn. She is survived by her loving family
