Mr. Gilley passed away Thursday, September 1, 2016 after a lengthy illness Tyler.

Bob served in the United States Army, 4th infantry and 25th infantry in Japan and Korea, as well as the Texas Baptist Men Disaster Relief from 1967-1996 as the Regional Director for about 20 years. He surrendered to the ministry in 1976 and was ordained as a Baptist Minister in 1988.

Bob was preceded in death by his loving wife Doris (Harden) Gilley; her parents; brothers, Rufus Gilley, Brady Gilley and Charles Gilley.

He is survived by his loving family including his brothers, Jack Gilley of Tyler, James Gilley of Miramar Beach, Florida, Jimmy Gilley of Wills Point; sisters, Barbara (Gilley) Sustaire, Betty (Gilley) Conner, Dora (Gilley) Evans and numerous nieces and nephews.
