

Cecil Jerl Roach

August 15, 1940 - July 19, 2018

Memorial services for Cecil Jerl Roach, 77, of Bullard, will be held at 2:00 p.m. Monday, July 23, 2018 at Green Acres Baptist Church under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home, with Rev. Scott Brown officiating. There will be a visitation one hour prior to the service.

Mr. Roach passed away at his home on Thursday, July 19, 2018. He was born August 15, 1940 in Lufkin to Mancel and Earline Roach.

Cecil attended Lufkin High School and SFA, playing football and running track. In 1962, he went to work for Massey and Brown Sporting Goods, which he later owned until 2000. He then opened Roach's Team Supply in 2003. Cecil loved his work and all the coaches that he called on throughout Texas. At the time of his death, he was employed by BSN Sports.

Cecil was preceded in death by his parents, infant sister and brother, Joe Roach. He is survived by his wife of 55 years, Joetta Roach; son, Kyle Roach (Amy); daughter, Kelly Roach Nichols (Kyle) both of Bullard; grandchildren (his pride and joy), Kylee Nichols of Dallas, Walker Roach (April), Will Roach (Karrigan), Klint Nichols and Weston Roach, Bailey and Lainey Kurtz all of Bullard; great-grandson, Cayson Roach; brother, Kenneth Roach (Thelma) of Lufkin; sister-in-law, Pat Meriweather of Lufkin; brothers-in-law, Bob Root (Merna) of Bullard, Paul Root (Tamesha) of Lufkin and Jeff Root (Cindy) of Tulsa, OK, as well as many nieces and nephews and more friends than can be imagined.
