



## Charles W. Bragg

November 30, 1951 - November 24, 2022

Memorial services for Charles William “Bill” Bragg, 70, of Flint, will be held at 10:00 a.m. Tuesday, December 6, 2022, at Stewart Family Funeral Home, with Rev. Sam Deville and Rev. Park Robertson officiating.
