Charlie was born on July 8, 1925 in Port Arthur, Texas to William J. and Agnes Armbruster Burch. He grew up in Port Arthur and attended Texas A&M University where he majored in Chemical Engineering. He served his country in the US Navy during World War II. After returning from the war, he graduated from Texas A&M and worked for the Pure Oil Company in Nederland, Texas. He met Mary Bess Guinn, a school teacher in Port Arthur, and they were married on June 16, 1951. They lived in Port Arthur, Texas, Arlington Heights, Illinois, and Beaumont, Texas before retiring to Tyler in 1991. After moving to Tyler, Charlie joined the Fifth Street Presbyterian Church.
