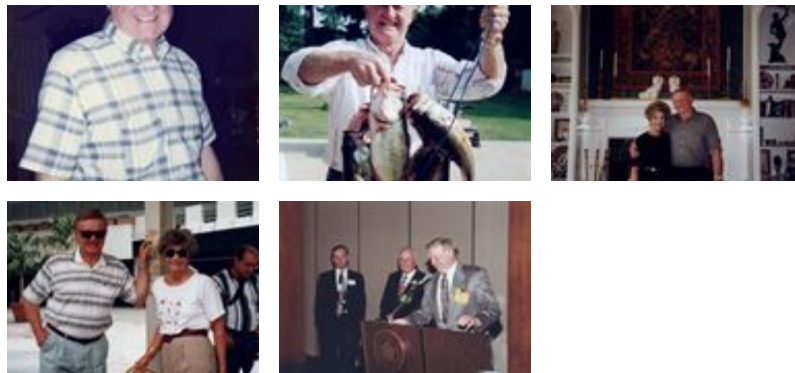
Coach brought so many good things to the athletic programs and classrooms. He taught respect and expected it in return. He brought and restored pride in our High School. He truly cared for all his students.
