Mr. Heard passed away Sunday, July 26, 2015 in Tyler.

He was born June 6, 1994 in Tyler to Christopher "Nace" and DeLisa Howe Heard.

Christopher was a member of First Christian Church and was a student ambassador delegate for People To People at age 13, traveling to England, Ireland and Whales while serving as a student ambassador. He attended Good Shepherd Academy and graduated from King's Academy Christian School in 2012. Christopher also attended TJC and UT Tyler. He was dedicated to the art of Kung Fu and spent many years at Tyler Kung Fu and Fitness. Christopher also participated in theater with Tyler Civic Theatre.

Christopher was preceded in death by his grandfather and grandmother, Max and Billie Heard, and grandfather Kenneth Howe, Jr.

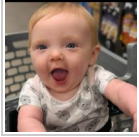

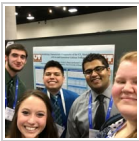

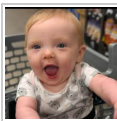
