Services for Clayre "Clay" Kirby, 82, of Tyler, will be held on Thursday, July 14, 2016, at 11:00 AM at West Erwin Church of Christ with Jay Lockhart and Larry Paul Fuller officiating.

Mrs. Kirby passed away Sunday, July 10, 2016 in Tyler after a long battle with Alzheimer's disease.

She was born January 12, 1934, in Conroe, TX to William Edgar and Lola Mamie Gray. She graduated from Gladewater High School in 1952, and Abilene Christian University in 1956. She later received her master's degree from Stephen F. Austin State University. Shortly after graduating from ACU, she married Jamon Kirby and began their great adventure together.

Clay spent her life devoted to teaching children in kindergarten. She taught for 34 years, 30 of which were spent at Andy Woods Elementary school. She loved her students, and was dedicated to making sure that they succeeded and thrived. She was also very involved in the children's Bible school program at West Erwin.

Clay was preceded in death by her father; her mother; her sister and brother-in-law, Louise and Elmo Hampton; brother-in-law, Al Fuller; sister-in-law and brother-in-law, Bill and Jewell Dean Rumsey; and nephew, Paul Rumsey.
