On January 28, 2009, God decided the time had come for Clefton H. Scott, Jr. to join his parents, Opal Scott and Clefton H. Scott, Sr. and his brother, Billy Joe Scott in Heaven. Clefton was born on October 22, 1936 in Kilgore, Texas. He attended Kilgore High School and Kilgore Junior College before attending the University of Texas and later earning a Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from the University of Houston. Clefton spent some time in the Army after attending UT and was stationed at Fort Dix. For many years, Clefton was a Claims Superintendent with State Farm Insurance Company. He was an avid and skilled fisherman, competing in tournaments throughout Texas as well as two professional B.A.S.S tournaments. Fishing was a skill taught to him by his grandfather. He would often recall those days as a child fishing with him. Clefton spent much of his life fighting a battle against heart disease. He overcame overwhelming obstacles including two heart attacks and a heart transplant. Throughout this long fight he always kept his gentle sense of humor, his concern for others and his unfaltering will to live. He will be remembered for his gentle and caring manner towards his family and all those who were fortunate enough to know him. His compassionate spirit extended beyond people. Clefton had a soft spot in his heart for animals as well. His friends and family remember his daily trips to the marina on Lake Conroe to feed the ducks or how much he loved his dogs.

Clefton is survived by his loving wife, Peggy of Tyler; his sons Ryan Scott and fiancé Christy of Beaumont and Derek Scott and wife Jennifer of
