Curtis Evans met his Lord face to face on Sunday, June 7, 2020. He proudly served his country in the Air Force during the Korean War and was stationed in Guam. Mr. Evans became a country club manager, where he received many honors and served as President of the Tennessee chapter of Club Managers for 4 years. He and his wife relocated to Tyler in 1976 to open the Western Sizzlin Steak House, and retired in 1991. He volunteered for P.A.T.H. and was an active member of Pleasant Retreat United Methodist Church. Curtis was the type of man that truly made an impact in the lives of the people he met and loved. He had a servant's heart, was generous and never missed an opportunity to help others. He rarely met a stranger, held his friends and family close to his heart and his absence will be felt by many.

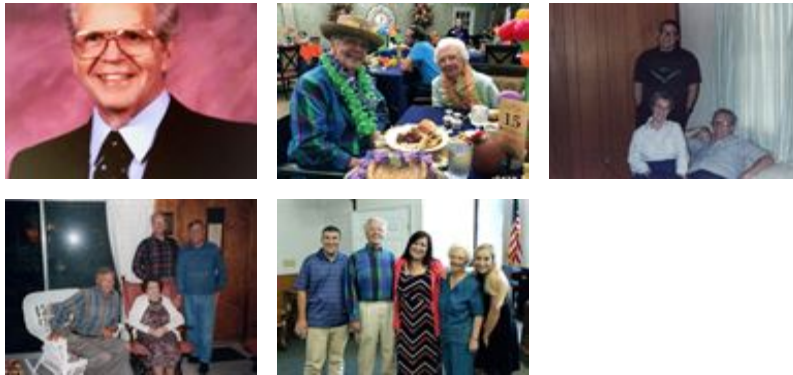
