Dan passed away, Monday, June 4, 2007 at the Reunion Plaza under the care of Legacy Hospice in Tyler. He was born September 11, 1931 in Ft. Thomas, KY to the late Frederick J. and Marguerite Gerhardstein. Dan was raised in Ft. Thomas, KY and graduated from Covington Latin High School and Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio in 1950. Three years later on August 15, 1953 he married his longtime sweetheart, Jeannine Hudson. After moving to Tyler in 1974 he had a long career with Tyler Pipe. He retired in 1995 then founded Fromm Airpad, Inc., Texas which introduced closed air cell package fill material into the United States. Daniel enjoyed spending time with his family, golfing with his grandson Jimmy, and especially teaching his family how to water ski. He was a devoted, loving, and generous father and husband. Dan was preceded in death by his parents, Frederick and Marguerite Gerhardstein and sister Marian Gerhardstein Fey.
