



Deborah "Debbie" Elaine Jones

Memorial services for Deborah "Debbie" Elaine Jones, 56, of Tyler, will be held on Sunday, September 4, 2016, at 3:00 PM at Pollard United Methodist Church with Rev. Richard Luna officiating. Visitation will follow the service at the church, under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Mrs. Jones passed away Wednesday, August 31, 2016 in Tyler.

She was born June 7, 1960 in Jacksonville to Dick and Jane McElmurry.

Debbie grew up in Tyler, graduating from Robert E. Lee High School, Tyler Junior College and the University of Texas at Tyler.

She was a math teacher at TJC and Robert E. Lee for over 30 years and was beloved by her students. She has also taught thousands of children to swim over the past 30 years. Debbie was a faithful member of Pollard United Methodist Church and Apache Bell Gold.

She was preceded in death by her father, Dick McElmurry and brothers, Dick, Jr., Mike and Phillip McElmurry.

Debbie is survived by her husband of 16 years, Jeff Jones; children, Tiffany Enfinger and husband Rusty, Adrian and fiancé' Emily, Mitch, Maddie, Meg, Matt and Misty Jones; sisters, Judy Murray and husband Joe, Pattie Fennell and husband Rick; brothers, Robbie McElmurry and wife Rhonda, Ronnie McElmurry and wife Emily; mother, Jane McElmurry and numerous nieces and nephews.

Debbie's most precious accomplishments were her children. She spent countless hours at swim meets, dance recitals and soccer, baseball and

football games. She had a special love of drill team and dance, having served as Captain of REL's Southern Belles and a member of the Apache Belles 32nd line. Debbie was so proud that 3 of her daughters have also been Southern Belles and 2 of her sons were Southern Belle Guards.

Two daughters have continued on to be 3rd generation Apache Belles, serving as Dance Captain and Head Dance Captain.

Honorary pallbearers will be TJC Apache Belles and the REL Southern Belles.

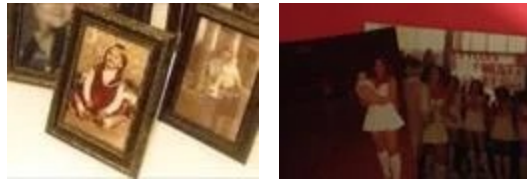

“ I'm so saddened to learn of the passing of Mrs. Debbie. We did swim lessons with her this summer after I found my 2 year old in the pool. He was fine but he made no attempt to get out and we couldn't get him to try to swim at all. So we drove from Nacogdoches to Tyler for a week and a half and Mrs. Debbie was amazing with him. He screamed the first 3 lessons but she didn't care. She was so practical, calm, sensible and just consistent. In the fourth lesson he was happy and started swimming even better. We were so impressed with her methods. Even my four year old perfected his swimming because she let him hang out on the other end of the pool during the lesson and had to swim unassisted.

My husband went to our last lesson with us and he and Mrs. Debbie talked and talked about church and life. She loved to talk about her children and she wanted to know about ours and asked lots of questions about my son's food allergies. She seemed to really care. She wanted to know about our church since my husband was a pastor.

When my husband and brother passed away a couple of weeks ago she was very concerned and my sister-in-law said she sent 15 messages checking on us. This has been a very tough time for my family and it struck a chord when I heard she had passed too. My husband, brother and Mrs. Debbie just didn't seem like ones that would be taken from us so soon. I immediately was heart-broken for the family but then I thought you know, she and Ryan can finish their conversations they enjoyed so much from heaven. I will be praying scripture over the family as I pray for my own too.

My deepest sympathy goes out to all the family and friends. I am at SFA and if you guys needs anything (She mentioned she was hoping her son would go there too) please let me know and I will get it done if I can't personally help. I was looking forward to seeing her at one of the games cheering on her daughter. I'll miss her after just knowing her a short time, I'm sure she will be missed so greatly by all.

Lastly, I would just like to share a verse that has helped me tremendously in the last 3 weeks. Romans 8:10 And Christ lives within you, so even though your body will die because of sin, the Spirit gives you life because you have been made right with God. The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you.
