Mrs. Brown went to be with her Lord and Savior on Sunday, December 29, 2019, in Tyler, Texas. She was born December 13, 1943, in Union City, Indiana to Harold Dunham and Mildred Harter-Dunham.

Dianna was a member of Rose Heights Church, where she attended faithfully every Sunday. She also enjoyed attending her Sunday School class, weekly ladies' Bible study and quilting guild. She graduated from Mississinawa Valley High School in Union City, Ohio. She was the ultimate stay-at-home mom until she joined her husband Bill in his medical practice. Because of this life changing event, she became a powerful prayer warrior, praying for others without ceasing. She always had a Bible verse to share with those who were hurting.
