



## Don Westhoff

August 12, 1931 - March 24, 2007

Don Westhoff passed away peacefully in his home with family by his side on March 24, 2007, at the age of 75. He was born August 12, 1931, in Weldona, Colorado, in the home of his parents Richard Francis and Verga Grace. After high school he spent two years on the family farm before entering the U.S. Army in February 1952, where he served in Korea until December 1952 with the rank of Corporal.
