Doris Alexander Lee was born on June 8, 1931 in New London to George and Fannye Pierce Alexander. She died on June 10, 2020 in Tyler, two days after her 89th birthday. 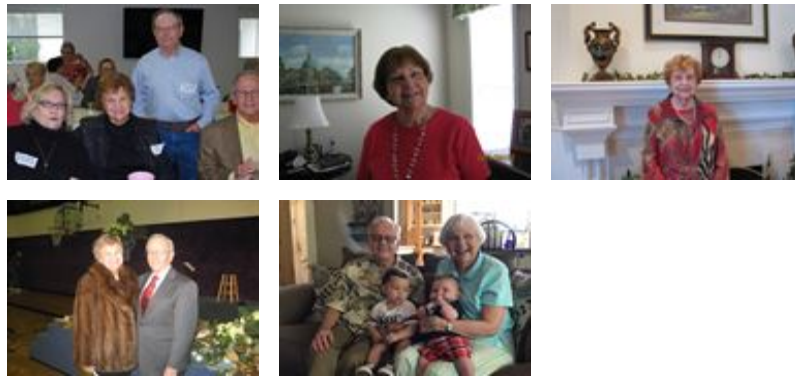
