



Douglas Hewitt

April 23, 1969 - March 14, 2012

We are celebrating the life of Douglas “Bo” Hewitt, 42, of Tyler, who passed away unexpectedly on March 14, 2012. During his youth, BO Hewitt thrived in the Boy Scouts of America, achieving the highest honor of Eagle Scout. Following graduation from Sharyland High School in McAllen, he enlisted in the US Air Force as a Security Policeman, serving his country in Operation Desert Storm. Upon completion in the USAF, Bo graduated from UT Pan American in Edinburg with a Bachelor’s Degree in History. He then earned his commission in the U.S. Army as an officer in the Signal Corps. Bo was stationed in Germany, a country he loved, and served in the NATO peacekeeping mission in Kosovo. Upon his discharge from the Army, Bo returned to his home state of Texas. Bo earned his Master’s Degree in Military History in 2007 from the American Military University and his Associate’s Degree in gunsmithing in 2009 from Yavapai College in Prescott, AZ. He married Mary McCracken in the spring of 2009 and the couple relocated to East Texas in 2010. Together, Bo and Mary opened their business, Hewitt Custom Gunsmithing, located in Frankston in March 2011. Bo was preceded in death by his father, William “Bill” Hewitt and grandparents. He is survived by his beloved wife, Mary McCracken of Tyler; and his mother, Nancy Woerner Hewitt, as well as many aunts, uncles, cousins and a host of friends.
