



Eddie Fitzgerald

April 26, 1925 - April 17, 2011

Eddie Ruth Loyd Fitzgerald passed away peacefully and surrounded by loving family members on April 17, 2011, at the Hospice of East Texas in Tyler. She was born on April 26, 1925 and grew up in Wood County, the eldest child of Edward McKinley Loyd and Ava Gilbreath Loyd. After graduating from Yantis High School, she married in 1948 and moved to Tyler in 1955. Her husband, Truman D. "Blue" Fitzgerald, an East Texas oil drilling contractor and rancher, preceded her in death in 2006.
