He was a dedicated member of Bethel Baptist Church for 54 years. Survivors include his loving wife of sixty-one years, Dorothy

Jarvis; son, Rodney Jarvis and wife Juanita; grandson, Roman Jarvis and wife Tuula; great-grandson, Alister; sister, Gay Locke and husband Bob; numerous nieces, nephews, cousins and a host of friends. Ed was preceded in
