He was born September 3, 1922 in Beachton, OK to John Amos and Mertie Gertrude Page Shaw. Mr. Shaw served in the Marine Corps during WWII. He graduated from the University of Oklahoma in 1952 with a Bachelors degree in Civil Engineering. Mr. Shaw started his career with the Federal Highway Administration at the National Road Test and went on to participate in the planning, design and construction of the Federal Interstate Highway System across the US. Emery served as Chief, Pavement Design in Washington DC and Division Administrator for Mississippi. After retirement from FHWA, he consulted on projects in Alaska including the construction of docks on the Yukon River. Emery enjoyed ranching, investing and most of all his family. Mr. Shaw was preceded in death by his parents, his wife of 68 years, Irma Lee Shaw on July 27, 2009 and daughter Sharon Dipprey, on July 28, 2009
