Eric Carson Eitel, 52, of Big Sandy, passed from this earth to his eternal Home with Jesus on Saturday, September 24, 2022.

Eric, the son of Billy and Carolyn Eitel, was born December 20, 1969, a redhead and received loads of attention throughout life. He graduated from Hubbard High School and enlisted in the United States Army. In the Army he served at Ft. Lewis in Seattle/Tacoma Washington and Nuremberg Germany. Eric served in Desert Storm and after four years left the military with an honorable discharge. He married his high school sweetheart, Robyn and moved to Big Sandy to the family farm. Eric started his career as a golf pro at Garden Valley. He served as manager at several clubs in East Texas and was blessed to find his home at Hollytree Country Club in Tyler where he exemplified servant leadership. Eric loved riding motorcycles and making music and spending time with his sons. He and Robyn loved taking the boys snow skiing in the winter and to the beach in the summer. Eric posted photos and memorable times with the family and friends to a group called "Southside of Heaven." We rest in the hope that one day we will reunite in Heaven with him. He left family, friends, and co-workers with many wonderful memories. Eric lived a life full of adventure and touched many lives in his own special way. He lived big and loved big and will be greatly missed.

Eric was preceded in death by his father, Billy "Bull" Eitel. He is survived by

his wife Robyn, and three sons: Colin Taylor and wife Lacy of Hubbard, TX and their children: Bryant, Amelya, Cameron, Caden, and Charlye Rose; William Carson Eitel and Josiah Carter Eitel of Big Sandy. 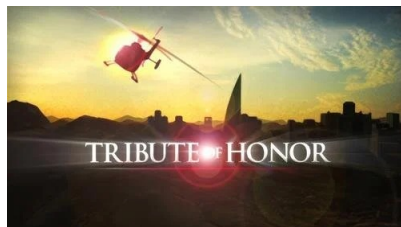

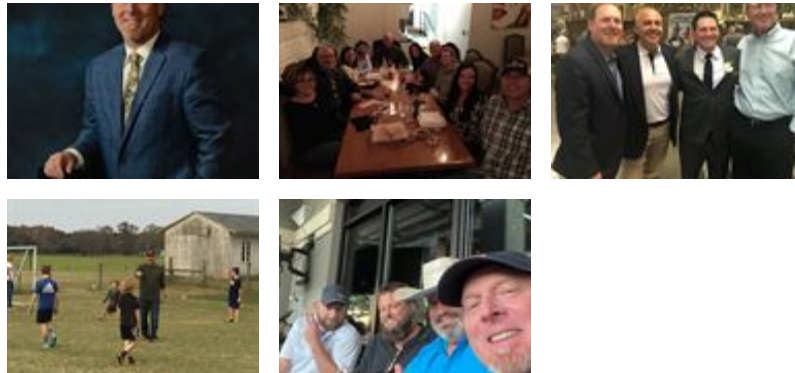
