Services for Faye C. Hayes, 94, of Tyler, TX will be held on April 15th, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. at Whitehouse Cemetery, 401 Memory Lane, in Whitehouse Texas, at the on-site Pavilion. After the service, Faye will be laid to rest with her loving husband, James Edsel Hayes, under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home.

Mrs. Hayes was born September 14th, 1928, in Bullard, TX to William David Cottrell and Malinda Addie (Pitts) Cottrell. She graduated from Whitehouse High School, Class of 1946, and attended studies at the Federal Institute where she graduated as a member of the 1947 class. Faye was employed as an accountant by Sam R. Hill Lumber Co. for 17 years, then by Tyler Savings and Loan for 10 years, and finally by First Federal Savings and Loan for 20 years, until she retired in 1993.

After that, Faye traveled the world, seeing all those places she had always wanted to visit. She traveled to Hawaii, Germany, France, the Holy Land, and even spent the turn of the Millennium on the London bridge, but her favorite, every time, was Alaska.

Faye was a devoted Christian, and a member of Green Acres Baptist Church in Tyler for many years. She often watched the televised services even after moving to Washington state with her daughter in 2017 and she deeply missed

her Sunday school class, and the friends she made there.

On the morning of Monday, October 17th 2022, in Spokane Valley, Washington, Faye left this world, surrounded by the love of family, and held securely in the arms of God.

“Miss Faye”, as her Washington state family lovingly referred to her, was preceded in death by her beloved husband, James Edsel Hayes, and her siblings, Charlie Milton Cottrell, Mildred Jean (Cottrell) Walker, Nina Marjorie (Cottrell) Jolley, and Billy Tracy Cottrell.
