Memorial services for Forrest P. Mr. Ploesser passed away, Sunday, August 21, 2011 at the Hospice of East Texas Homeplace in Tyler. He was born October 3, 1932 in St. Louis, MO. to Forrest Phillip Sr. and Marie Murphy Ploesser.
