Mr. Freeman passed away Sunday, January 13, 2019 in Webster, TX. He was born June 25, 1949 in Jacksonville to Thusus Freeman and Mattie Allen Freeman.

Freddie was a member of Bethel Hope Church, Tyler, TX, an ordained Deacon, Sunday school teacher, lead male singer of the church Male Chorus, a member of Thursday Night Mixed Bowling League, and FDHS Class of 1967 Alumni Co-Treasurer. He held the position of Tire Assembly Associate with Kelly Springfield, where he was the 1994 National Spirit Award Winner, a member of the Employee Assistance Program, as a link to recovery for associates and families coping with alcohol addiction or substance abuse, a member of the problem-solving work team, the Joint Steering Committee and was an executive board member and trustee in the Local 747 Union.

Damar; daughter, D'Jamalia Vivette (Dwayne); granddaughter, Dionne; and god-grandkids, Jayla (bff), Jordyn, and Jayden Thompson.
