He was born August 17, 1941 in Wichita, Kansas to Gale Forest and Eva Maye Dickson Wimberly. Mr. Wimberly is a 1959 graduate of Whitehouse ISD and graduated from Stephen F. Austin University in 1964 with a degree in Agriculture Science. Garry was a 61 year resident of Smith County and an active member of Mt. Carmel Baptist Church where he was a Sunday School teacher. Mr. Wimberly was a Charter Member and Treasurer of Whitehouse Young Farmers Association, past President and member of the Whitehouse ISD School Board, active supporter of Smith County 4-H, Whitehouse FFA and Treasurer for Smith County Livestock Association.
