Georgia Collins Mason, 75, passed away Saturday, November 28, 2015. A celebration of her life will be held at Stewart Family Funeral Home, Monday, November 30, 2015 at 2:00 PM followed by her burial at Cathedral in the Pines Cemetery. as two different quartets. In addition to her singing groups, she loved karaoke and making music with all her kids. She spent a lot of her time researching genealogy and was fascinated by her family history.

In 1985, she and Gene gained custody of their first grandchild, Ronnie, and they became full-time parents again. She spent many days at his school with her camera, creating personalized photo albums for every child in Ronnie's class at All Saints Episcopal School. As a room mother, she organized the annual sock hop, and enjoyed serving kids in the cafeteria. Most of the class of 2004 called her "Grandma".
