



Gilbert Allgaier

August 28, 1930 - May 8, 2009

Mass for Gilbert George Allgaier, 78, of Tyler will be celebrated at 11:00 AM on Tuesday, May 12, 2009 at St. Mary Magdalene Catholic Church, 18221 FM 2493, in Flint with Father Timothy Kelly officiating under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Mr. Allgaier passed away on May 8, 2009 in Tyler.

He was born August 28, 1930 in Chicago, IL to the late Carl and Delores Allgaier. He grew up in Maywood, CA and attended St. Rose of Lima Catholic Schools. He married Elizabeth Falche on July 14, 1951 at St. Rose of Lima Catholic Church in Maywood, CA. Mr. Allgaier served in the Korean War and had a long career working for Kimberly Clark Corporation. He moved with his job to Aiken, SC, Conway, AR, Corinth, MS, San Juan del Rio, Mexico, Neenah, WI and Roswell, GA. During that time, he traveled to 32 countries and 44 different locations, spending time in the Far East, Central and South America and Europe. He enjoyed working in the yard and on his automobiles.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Allgaier was preceded in death by a brother, Carl, and a sister, Margarita. He is survived by his wife, Elizabeth (Elisa); children, Carl and wife Teresa of Roswell, GA, Michael and wife Bernice of Whitehouse, Larry and wife Janet of Cincinnati, OH; former daughter-in-law, Teresa; grandchildren, Brian and wife Michelle, Jessica, Kevin, Daniel, Terra and Lance Allgaier; and nieces and nephews.
