Jeanie passed away Monday, February 21, 2022 in Whitehouse. She was born December 15, 1947 in Dallas and raised in Houston by her beloved parents Glenn Carl Outhouse and Jeanette McKnight Outhouse. 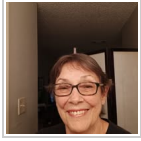
