Mrs. Hendrix went to be with her Lord and Savior on Thursday, April 14, 2016 in Dallas.

She was born October 8, 1925 in Dallas to Carl and Minette Marder. She graduated from Woodrow Wilson High School in Dallas.

Gloria moved to Tyler in 1946 where she lived until after her husband's death in 2009 eventually moving back to Dallas to be closer to her family. She was a homemaker and a faithful member of Green Acres Baptist Church, where she was an active member of The Joy Sunday school class. She served as Chairman of the Kitchen committee for several years. She was also a past President of the Tyler Woman's Forum and enjoyed many years of working with the Tyler Rose Festival. She has been a member of the Pythian Sisters since 1946.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Hendrix was preceded in death by her husband of 65 years Ralph Hendrix; brother, Carl Marder; sister, Barbara Ann Marder.
