October 1, 1946 - February 17, 2011

A funeral mass for Gregory James Paige, 64, of Tyler, will be held Monday, February 21, 2011, at 11:00 AM at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception with Very Rev. Anthony McLaughlin and Msgr. Joe Strickland officiating. Arrangements are under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Mr. Paige passed away February 17, 2011 at Hospice of East Texas. He was born October 1, 1946 in Syracuse, NY to Robert Eugene and Katherine Helen Banach Paige. A member of the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception for 30 years, Greg served his faith community as a choir member and cantor soloist. Greg is a Vietnam Veteran, a member of the Knights of Columbus, a member of the Pilot Club of Tyler, and often sang with the Tyler Civic Chorale. He graduated from Blodgett Vocational High School in Syracuse, NY, class of 1964. He was a computer systems programmer for 40 years at Carrier Air Conditioning. Gregory was preceded in death by his father.
