Guenter Schnetzinger passed away peacefully on November 21, 2022. He is survived by his wife, Ute, his children Diane, Claudia, and Glenn, and nine beloved grandchildren.

Guenter was born on December 20, 1940 in Hanau, Germany. He had a master's degree in Hair Design and was a color expert for Wella Corporation in Germany. He traveled extensively to demonstrate and train others in his craft. In 1965, those skills became the foundation for his immigration to the United States; what was planned to be a three-year assignment became his permanent home and country.

Together with his wife Ute, Guenter followed his passions for the arts. All his life, Guenter loved growing plants. He transitioned his work to landscaping and together with his wife, founded Gunter's Greenhouse in Richardson. The business grew and he ultimately became the largest orchid grower in North Texas.

He was an active member of Fellowship Bible Church in Dallas, and later, Grace Community Church in Tyler.

Guenter was a wonderful husband and father, a friend to all, and loved His heavenly father, Jesus Christ. His family and friends have peace knowing that

Guenter is with his Savior and hold on to the faith that they will see each other again. Guenter's joyful presence will remain in the hearts of his family and his stories will live on.
