Corbin passed away on June 17, 2011 in Tyler. He was born on August 5, 1927 in Dallas to the late Horace George Corbin, Sr. and Lena Gillham Corbin. He was a 1944 graduate of Tyler High School and a 1948 graduate of Tyler Junior College. He was in the United States Navy from 1945 until 1946, serving aboard the USS Gustafson, the USS Eldridge, and in the Naval Reserve. He married Sue Doremus on September 29, 1949 and they settled in Tyler where Mr. Corbin owned the Tyler Stamp and Coin Company for many years. He was a member of the American Numismatic Association for 61 years, a life member of the Texas Numismatic Association, a life member of the Central States Society, a member of the Professional Numismatist Guild, a charter member of the Society of Paper Money, a member of the Orders and Medals Society of America, a charter member of the Smith County Historical Society, and a member of the American Legion.

Mr. Corbin is survived by a loving family including his wife of 61 years, Sue Corbin of Tyler; his daughter, Janet Sinopoli and husband, Albert; and his grandson, Albert William Sinopoli, all of Covington, Louisiana.
