February 19, 1930 - March 5, 2007

Memorial services for Harold Allison Brasfield, Tyler, will be held Wednesday, March 7, at 11 a.m. at First Presbyterian Church, 230 West Rusk Street, Tyler, with Dr. Stuart Baskin officiating. A private burial will be held before the service at Cathedral in the Pines Cemetery. After a lengthy illness, Harold passed away Monday, March 5, at East Texas Medical Center. Harold was born to Major and Katie Brasfield on February 19, 1930 in Texarkana, Texas. He grew up in Poynor, Texas. Harold graduated from Orange High School and attended Henderson County Junior College. He received his B. S. degree from East Texas State University in Commerce. Harold was a geophysicist for Humble Oil Company. In 1965, he formed his own company, Brasfield Oil & Gas. He was instrumental in the discovery of many oil fields in East Texas and continued to be very active in the oil business until his death. Harold lived life to the fullest and enjoyed nothing more than spending time with his many friends. He loved to travel and cook. In addition to his parents, he was also preceded in death by his brother, John Brasfield and mother-in-law, Tish Orr.
