



## Harold Hamons

He received the American Campaign Medal, Asiatic Pacific Campaign Medal with two Bronze Stars, Good Conduct Medal, the Victory Ribbon and three Overseas Bars. He also served in the Okinawa and Saipan Campaigns and was discharged as 305th Fighter Control 7th Air Force. Harold was a 32 Degree Shriner, St. Johns Lodge #53 Masons, Knight Templar, Waco Scottish Rite and York Rite. Harold was a self taught watchmaker, jeweler, clock and typewriter repairman along with numerous other repair talents. He began work with Chesney Jewelers in Dallas and continued with Davidson Jewelers in Hugo, Oklahoma, East Texas Typewriter and retired from Robins Music after 17 years. Mr. Hamons was preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his loving family including his wife, Wilma; daughter, Donna and Grandson, Charlie Hedrick.
