Funeral services for Homer Cornelius Green, 83, Tyler are scheduled for Tuesday, June 3, 2008 at 10:00 AM at Stewart Family Funeral Home with the Reverend Tim Roberts officiating. Burial will follow in Rose Hill Cemetery under the direction of Stewart Family Funeral Home. Mr. Green died Saturday, May 31, 2008 in Tyler. He was born January 16, 1925 in Waco to the late James Homer and Bess Casey Green. He was a member of Green Acres Baptist Church and graduated from Tyler High School in 1942. He served in the U.S. Air Force during World War II and was stationed in Japan at one time. He worked as an abstract clerk in the general office of Cotton Belt Railroad before entering locomotive services as a locomotive fireman and became a locomotive engineer in 1957. In 1969 he was appointed Road Foreman of Engines at Pine Bluff, Arkansas, then onto Houston on the company's Southern Pacific parent and to Indio, California, before returning to Tyler in 1976 where he became Trainmaster-Road Foreman. He retired after over 40 years service with the railroad. He was a member of the Dallas Scottish Rite-St. John's Masonic Lodge No. 53, a charter member of the Sharon Shrine Temple, and a former member of the Jeep Patrol. Homer is survived by his wife of 57 years, Elva Green of Tyler, one son Glenn Green and wife Kay of Tyler, and two grandchildren Megan and Matthew Green, both of Tyler. Pallbearers will be Bob Lamb, David Agnew, Larry Ivy, Eddie Ivy, Carl Ivy and Shannon Strickland.
